## Gardasil 9 Series Injections

To our patients over the age of 26:

Physicians at Gynecology Oncology & Pelvic Surgery may advise Gardasil 9 vaccination during the course of your care. The current Standards of Care show a benefit to women fighting some gynecologic conditions and/or cancers, and therefore, the vaccination is recommended for some women **over the age of 26**.

1. **FDA Approval** – Gardasil 9 is FDA approved for women 9-26.
2. **Coverage** – Generally, insurance plan benefits include coverage for Gardasil 9, when it is within FDA approved use (meaning, it is covered when it is given to women ages 9-26).
3. **Non Coverage** – Frequently, insurance plan benefits **do not** include coverage for Gardasil 9, when it is outside FDA approved use (meaning, it is **not** covered when it is given to women over the age of 26).

Since insurance does not cover Gardasil injections for women over the age of 26, we would require pre-payment for the series of injections.

**90651** – Human papillomavirus 9-valent Vaccine, Recombinant, 3-dose schedule, for intramuscular use. **\$392.00**

**90471** – Immunization administration (includes percutaneous, intradermal, subcutaneous, or intramuscular injections); one vaccine (single combination vaccine/toxoid). **\$65.00**

**Total \$457.00**

Private Pay discount of 30% is applied to these fees and the final payment from the patient would be **\$319.90 – per injection**.
