Who We Are

Northwest Hope & Healing was founded by Christine Smith in 2000, roughly two months after she was diagnosed with breast cancer. The mission she envisioned from the beginning is the same today: to provide financial assistance to local patients in need who are battling breast and gynecologic cancer and receive their treatment at a Swedish Cancer

Institute throughout the region.



What We Do

Our Patient Assistance Fund provides assistance for everyday living expenses such as groceries, reliable transportation, rent assistance, and childcare. Our signature "Healing Boxes" are assembled and delivered, at no charge, to local patients who are newly diagnosed with breast or gynecologic cancer.

We contribute to the healing of those being treated for breast or gynecologic cancer in the Puget Sound region by providing immediate assistance for everyday basics, community, and ongoing survivor support.

A Letter from the President of the Board

Since our founding, Northwest Hope & Healing has been dedicated to supporting breast and gynecologic cancer patients and their families. We are persistent in our efforts to provide assistance to as many patients as possible because every cancer patient deserves security, community, and hope for the future.

Over the past three years, we have faced many challenges in adapting to the COVID-19 pandemic. Despite these obstacles, we continued to provide essential financial assistance, becoming the only organization in Seattle that provides financial support exclusively to breast and gynecologic cancer patients. As we began to move away from the pandemic in 2022, we faced the challenge of determining what Northwest Hope & Healing looks like in a post-pandemic world.

We conducted a strategic planning retreat at the start of 2022 to answer this question and consequently identified four strategic goals:

- Increase support for cancer patients and build a network of hope for survivors
- Update the Northwest Hope & Healing brand with the intent to increase awareness
- Maintain a robust fundraising plan
- Maintain operations and continue to build our infrastructure.

Northwest Hope & Healing is proud to have met these goals thanks to our determined staff, dedicated board, and generous donors.

2022 was a year of transition in leadership. We said goodbye to our Executive Director of five years, Karyn Blasi Hellar. We'd like to thank Karyn for her excellent guidance to get Northwest Hope and Healing through the pandemic. In August, we welcomed Tricia Johnson as our new Executive Director. She has seamlessly transitioned and already made huge strides in all aspects of her role. We are lucky to have her leadership.

Thanks to you, our generous friends and supporters, 2022 was a year of record-breaking fundraising. At the fun-filled fashion show and auction, Life in Color, **a fantastic \$450,000 was raised.** Thank you to everyone who was in attendance and gave so generously to support breast and gynecologic cancer patients who are struggling financially.

Your contributions provide assistance to breast and gynecologic patients receiving care at a Swedish Cancer Institute through the Patient Assistance Fund. Each year Northwest Hope & Healing's contribution to the fund has grown, and 2022 is no different. We were thrilled to contribute \$200,000, collectively distributing more than \$2,000,000 in grants over the past 20 years.

PATIENT RECEIVING CARE AT SWEDISH CANCER INSTITUTE

Impact Snapshot

In **2022**, Northwest Hope & Healing contributed **\$200,000** to the Swedish Cancer Institute Patient Assistance Fund, resulting in a total contribution of **\$2,000,000** over **22** years.

Regardless of income, any patient diagnosed with a breast or gynecologic cancer is eligible for up to \$600 in one-time assistance. Patients with significant financial need are eligible for an additional \$200. There are currently 89 recipients that are living with Stage IV cancer. These recipients are eligible for grants of \$600 each year they are in treatment. Gift cards are the top request for patient use, for groceries and other necessities. Grant requests were primarily used for transportation, utilities, and housing.




Serving Families

Many patients are the primary earners in their families, but report insufficient or lack of income due to unexpected expenses, job loss, etc. We recognize that patients who also care for children may be in need of additional funds. In December, \$7,500 in funds from Northwest Hope & Healing supported the Swedish Cancer Institute Holiday Families program. This funding paid for the purchasing of \$250 Fred Meyer gift cards for 30 breast or gynecologic cancer patents and their families.




