## A YEAR OF EXPANDING OUR REACH

We serve patients from 13 counties in WA and Alaska.



In **2023**, Northwest Hope & Healing contributed **\$225,000** to the Swedish Cancer Institute Patient Assistance Fund, resulting in a total contribution of more than **\$2,500,000** over **23** years.

Regardless of income, any patient diagnosed with a breast or gynecologic cancer is eligible for up to \$1,000 in assistance. Gift cards for groceries and other necessities are the top request for patient use. Grant requests were primarily used for transportation, utilities, and housing.

NWHH enters the year filled with optimism and determination. The Board of Directors gather to create a two year Strategic Plan that aims to increase our scope and impact.

The community celebrates Valentine's Day by sending Healing Boxes to local cancer patients. \$1,000 is raised to support this cause through the Hearts of Hope initiative, providing 40 Healing Boxes to those in need.

**MAR 2023**

We come together to commemorate Women's History Month and celebrate the strength, courage, and resiliency of women facing cancer.

**APR 2023**

The very first NWHH Annual Report hits the inboxes of supporters highlighting the incredible accomplishments of the 2022 year.

**MAY 2023**

NWHH acknowledges World Ovarian Cancer Day. We proudly support ovarian cancer patients on their journey to healing.

**JUN 2023**

Donida Farm hosts the Summer Dressage Competition, a weekend filled with fun activities benefitting Northwest Hope & Healing.

**JUL 2023**

**OCT 2023**

The Pink Ribbon Army leads the charge as twenty-five local businesses raise funds in honor of Breast Cancer Awareness Month. They raise an incredible \$100,000 for local breast cancer patients.

**NOV 2023**

The Life in Color models of 2022 and 2023 reunite in Fremont at the Model Reunion. The Cups of Comfort initiative provides 60 Starbucks gift cards in Healing Boxes.

**DEC 2023**

NWHH ends the year on a high point, distributing \$225,000 to Swedish Cancer Institute, the largest contribution in history.
